SUNDAY IS THE SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD 2026

“The Word of Christ dwells among you”. Col. 3 :16 Seven years ago Pope Francis created this Sunday for us to appreciate all the more the gift of the Bible. Let us think about how we can reflect upon the Sacred Scriptures and live out God’s Word from week to week. This weekend the children for Confirmation and First Holy Communion are asked with their families to place the bible, perhaps a special children’s Bible in a prominent place in their home and to take some time in the weeks of preparation to read together some of the Bible stories.

“After the Holy Year, this motto remains for us a precious inheritance: an invitation addressed to the whole Church to place the Gospel once more at the centre, since every true renewal is born from docile listening to the Word. To welcome it means allowing ourselves to be accompanied by the One who does not deceive, because He gives life and hope. To be inhabited by the Word ultimately means permitting Christ to speak even today through our lives, so that every person may recognize His presence, which continues to illuminate the journey of history”. *Liturgical and Pastoral Handbook 2026*
